

Adriatic LNG: the company

Terminale GNL Adriatico Srl, also known as **Adriatic LNG**, is an Italian joint venture established on May 2, 2005, controlled by ExxonMobil Italiana Gas (~71%) - a company belonging to ExxonMobil Group, Qatar Terminal Company Limited (~22%) - a company belonging to Qatar Petroleum Group, and Snam Spa (~7%).

Adriatic LNG is the company that designed, built and now operates the regasification terminal located in the province of Rovigo, 15 kilometers off the Venetian coast. The terminal has been operational since 2009 and has a regasification capacity of 8 billion cubic meters a year. Adriatic LNG has 125 employees distributed among the headquarters in Milan, the Shore Base at Porto Viro (Rovigo) and the offshore terminal.

ExxonMobil is the largest publicly traded international oil and gas company and uses technology and innovation to help meet the world's growing energy needs. ExxonMobil holds an industry-leading inventory of resources and is one of the world's largest integrated refiners, marketers of petroleum products and chemical manufacturers.

Qatar Petroleum (QP) is a state-owned public corporation established in 1974. It is responsible for all phases of the oil and gas industry in the State of Qatar.
